- The Amnesty Society seeks to promote a safe environment and this will be secured by a proactive approach to Health and Safety.
- The Amnesty Society takes a partnership approach to Health and Safety.

### Duty of Care

- The Amnesty Society recognises its legal responsibility to ensure, in so far as is reasonably practicable, that all activities are undertaken in a safe and healthy manner and that you do not cause injury by negligent acts and omissions.
- Acknowledging that we must be in a position to demonstrate that you have fulfilled your duty of care to the participants in your activity. Negligent acts and omissions are not deliberate, but often the incident and/or injury is foreseeable. The law of negligence seeks to ensure that as individuals we are responsible for our actions and in-actions and that we consider those who might be injured or harmed by those acts or omissions.
- The Amnesty Society will combat this by identifying potential hazards and threats and putting in place reasonable controls, the risk of an accident or incident happening is reduced.

### Risk Management

The Amnesty Society takes a proactive approach to risk management is proactive rather than reactive and aims to create a safer environment and operational procedures. Risk management is an ongoing process that is be applied to all your club's policies and procedures.
